

GIRO Scheme

To participate in the GIRO scheme, you have to fill up the application form and return it to LTA. We will notify you once the application is approved. Meanwhile, if your road tax is expiring, you may continue to renew your road tax by other alternative methods.

About one month before the expiry of your road tax and vehicle radio licence, LTA will notify you through a payment schedule of the GIRO deduction date. The amount payable for your road tax and vehicle radio licence will be deducted on the vehicle's road tax expiry date. However, if the road tax expiry falls on a non-working day (i.e. Saturday, Sunday or Public Holiday), the GIRO deduction will be brought forward one working day before the road tax expiry date. In the payment schedule, you will also be advised what are the renewal pre-requisites you must fulfilled by a certain date in order to facilitate a successful GIRO deduction. Examples of some road tax renewal pre-requisites are: sufficient motor insurance coverage, passed vehicle inspection, etc. You must also ensure that there are sufficient funds in the bank account on the deduction date.

Upon a successful GIRO deduction, a validated road tax disc (with any payment of vehicle radio licence fee indicated) will be mailed to you within 7 days. You have up to 14 days (excluding Sunday and Public Holiday) from the last road tax expiry date to display the new road tax disc.
