

Road Tax GIRO Payment Scheme

To participate in the GIRO scheme, you have to fill up the application form and return it to LTA. We will notify you once the application is approved. Meanwhile, if your road tax is expiring, you should continue to renew your road tax by other alternative methods.

About one month before the expiry of your road tax, LTA will notify you through a payment schedule of the GIRO deduction date. The amount payable for your road tax will be deducted on the vehicle's road tax expiry date. However, if the road tax expiry falls on a non-working day (i.e. Saturday, Sunday or Public Holiday), the GIRO deduction will be brought forward one working day before the road tax expiry date. On the GIRO deduction date, you must ensure that there are sufficient funds in the designated bank account.

In the payment schedule, you will also be advised on the renewal pre-requisites you must fulfilled by a certain date in order to facilitate a successful GIRO deduction. Some examples of road tax renewal pre-requisites are: sufficient motor insurance coverage, passed vehicle inspection, etc.

You can go to our online service, "Road Tax Payable/Calculator" to check whether your vehicle has fulfilled all the required pre-requisite(s) by the date stipulated in the payment schedule. If you are unable to fulfill all the pre-requisites on time, the GIRO deduction will not take place. You must renew your road tax promptly by other alternative methods.

Upon a successful GIRO deduction, a validated road tax disc will be mailed to you within 5 working days. You have up to 14 days (excluding Sunday and Public Holiday) from the last road tax expiry date to display the new road tax disc. If you do not receive the validated disc after the 5 working days, please contact our customer service officers at 1800 CALL LTA (1800 2255 582).

When a GIRO application is approved, the vehicle will be on the GIRO Scheme until the registered owner of the vehicle writes to notify LTA to terminate the arrangement. However, the GIRO arrangement of the vehicle will be terminated automatically when:

- there is a transfer of vehicle ownership;
- the vehicle is de-registered; or
- there is a change in the registered vehicle owner's identification type or number (e.g. from a Passport Number to a Singapore's NRIC Number).
