

ENHANCED REAR & SIDE MARKING REQUIREMENTS FOR LONG VEHICLES

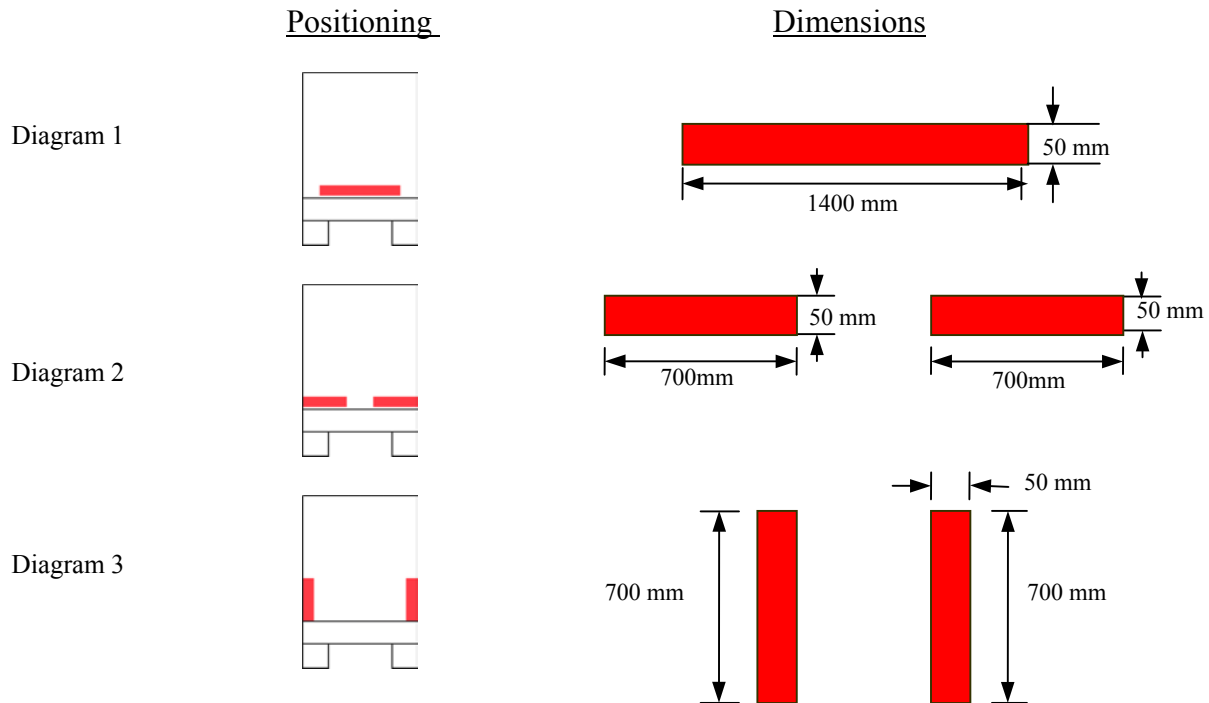
(I) Rear Markings

Colour and type:

Constructed of **red** retro-reflective material which complies with the specifications for retro-reflective markings of Class C set out in the UN ECE Regulation No.104

Positioning and dimensions:

Rear of the vehicle and in accordance with either diagram 1, 2 or 3 as shown below:



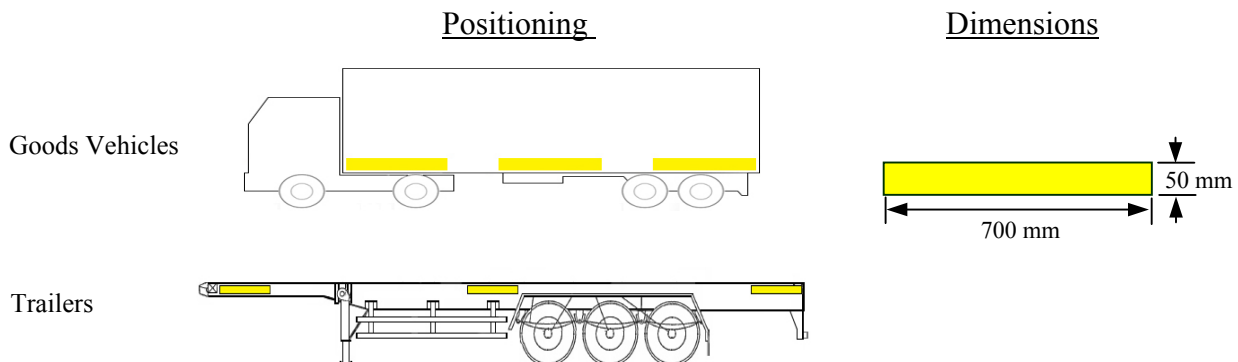
(II) Side markings

Colour and type:

Constructed of **yellow** retro-reflective material which complies with the specifications for retro-reflective markings of Class C set out in the UN ECE Regulation No.104

Positioning and dimensions:

At least 3 markings on each side of the vehicle. In the case of a trailer, one marking each fitted within one metre from the front and rear, and the third fitted at the midpoint of the trailer. In the case of a goods vehicle, one marking fitted within one metre from the front end of the cargo compartment, one marking within one metre from the rear end of the vehicle, and the third fitted at the midpoint (between the aforementioned markings).



Note: Each marking shall carry at least one approval mark, which consists of the letter “E”, imprinted legibly and permanently on it. A sample of the approval mark for markings that comply with the UN ECE Regulation No.104 is shown below:
