



#### Centre Double White Lines

- Vehicles are not allowed to cross these lines. No parking on both sides of the road at all times



#### Single Yellow Line

- No parking on that side of the road between 7am and 7pm except on Sundays and public holidays



#### Double Yellow Lines

- No parking on that side of the road at all times



#### Single Yellow Zigzag Line

- No parking on that side of the road at all times. Stopping for loading/unloading of passengers is permitted



#### Single White Zigzag Lines

- Advance warning of the presence of a zebra crossing. No overtaking, waiting or parking in the vicinity



#### Double Yellow Zigzag Lines

- No stopping on that side of the road at all times

## Drive Very Carefully at School Zone

Red textured road surface near most schools' gates makes school zones more obvious.



Prominent traffic signs indicating the start and end of school zones to remind motorists to drive carefully.

When driving in school zones:

- Slow down and drive more carefully
- Be extra vigilant to watch out for children crossing the road
- Be patient when you encounter heavy traffic at school zones during school peak hours
- If you drive your children to/from school, drop off or pick up at safe and proper places

## Obey Traffic Light Signals

Signals convey important messages and help traffic move smoothly.

While most signals look familiar, their messages are often misunderstood by motorists.



**RED**

: "Stop". Do not start to move until the green light appears in your favour.



**AMBER**

: "Stop" unless you are so close to the stop-line when the lights turn AMBER that you cannot stop safely.

**FLASHING AMBER**: The traffic light signals are out of order. Proceed with caution. Give way to traffic on the right.



**GREEN**

: "Go". Look to the right and left to ensure it is safe before you proceed.

When approaching traffic junctions with arrows



• **STOP** behind the stop-line in the direction indicated (Do not turn right even when there is no traffic from the opposite direction)



• **READY TO STOP** behind the stop-line in the direction indicated



• **GO** in the direction indicated (Turn right)

Examples:



"Go" if going straight.

"Stop" and wait behind the stop-line if turning right.



"Go" if going straight.

Wait for opposing traffic to clear and pedestrians to finish crossing the road before turning right.

## Left Turn On Red (LTOR)



Proceed only when the way is clear and it is safe to do so



## Comply with Road Markings



### Centre Broken White Line on a Two-Way Road

- Vehicles should keep to the left of this line



### Stop Line

- Stop to check the traffic situation ahead before moving off



### Double Broken White Lines

- Give way to traffic on major road



### Centre White Line

- Vehicles should keep to the left of this line. No parking on both sides of the road at all times
