

KNOW YOUR SIGNS

TRIANGLE+RED border

Warning Signs

Warn of possible danger or unusual road conditions ahead.



ROUND+BLUE background

Mandatory Signs

Compulsory to comply with. It's an offence to disobey them.



CIRCLE+RED border

Prohibitory Signs

Inform road users of special prohibitions. Failure to comply constitutes an offence.



RECTANGLE+COLOURED background

Informative Signs

Provide information such as the directional sign shown here which is rectangular with a green background.

SHAPES & COLOURS
