

## PUTTING UP SIGNBOARDS IN PUBLIC PLACES

Advertisement banners and signs are not allowed along the road. They clutter and mar the streetscape. They tend to compete for attention with traffic and pose a distraction to road users.

It is an offence to put up signboards in public places without approval. Offenders can be fined up to \$2,000.

However, signs such as temporary directional signs that lead to show flats of new developments can be allowed, subject to approval.
