



Upgrading of Woodsville Interchange

Improving Road Network & Enhancing Driving Experiences

The Woodsville Interchange, located at the intersection of Serangoon Road, Upper Serangoon Road, MacPherson Road and Bendemeer Road, is a very complex road intersection with connecting slip roads to and from the existing Pan-Island Expressway (PIE).

Currently, the peak hour traffic volumes at this intersection are very high and are very close to its capacity. With the anticipated growth in traffic due to the further development in the Northeast sector, the present intersection will be inadequate to cope with the future traffic demand. Hence, it is necessary to upgrade the Woodsville Interchange.

Project Details

The upgraded interchange includes:

- Construction of a 255-metre long two-lane vehicular tunnel from Serangoon Road to Upper Serangoon Road;
- Construction of a 245-metre long two-lane vehicular tunnel from Upper Serangoon Road to Bendemeer Road;
- Construction of a 160-metre long one-lane vehicular tunnel from MacPherson Road to Bendemeer Road;
- Construction of a 400-metre long one-lane flyover from Pan-Island Expressway (PIE) slip road to Kallang Way; and
- Reconfiguration of the existing at-grade junction to improve the overall traffic flow.

What You Can Look Forward To

- **Seamless traveling experience** through the tunnels
- **Shorter traveling time** with uninterrupted connection when motorists drive through the tunnels and more direct turning movements at the at-grade junction
- **Shorter waiting time** at the reconfigured junction
- **Direct access from PIE slip road to Kallang Way** via the new flyover
