

DIRECTIONAL SIGNS

1. Directional signs are usually rectangular with a green background. There are two types: Advance and Confirmation Directional Signs. Confirmation Directional Signs have a chevron shape on one end to indicate the direction.



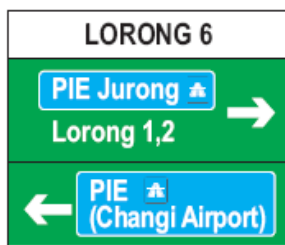
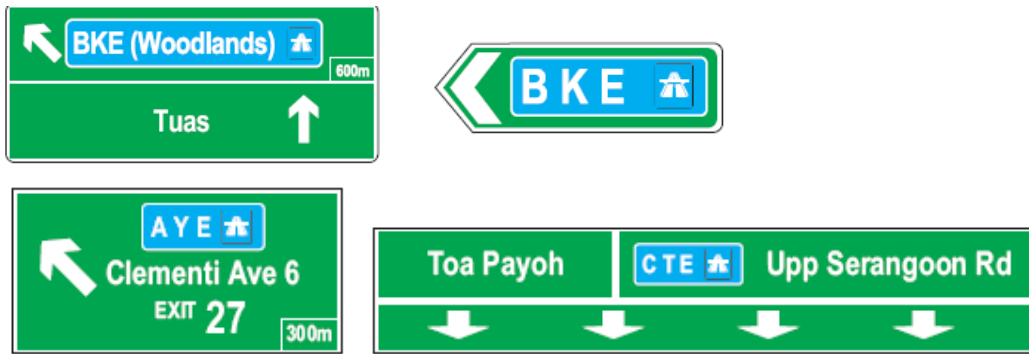
2. On all roads leading to destinations along expressways, the signs have either:

a) Yellow letters on green backgrounds with yellow borders, which will be phased out;



Or

b) White lettering on green backgrounds, and the white text describing an expressway destination, is encased in a blue background.



Additional information on some directional signs have black letters on white backgrounds with black borders. The sign provides information on the road that you are approaching.

3. On all roads leading to destinations along roads other than expressways, the signs have white letters on green backgrounds with white borders.
