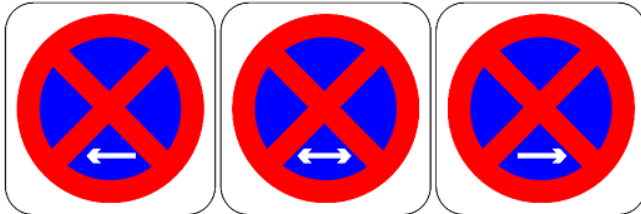


PROHIBITORY SIGNS

Failure to comply with these signs constitutes an offence.



No entry for all vehicles



No stopping



No waiting
(Vehicles may stop to allow boarding or alighting only)



No waiting and No loading/unloading during stated hours



No right turn



No left turn



Width limit

(This sign prohibits the entry of vehicles with width in excess of 2.3m. The numerals on the sign may be altered to indicate different width restriction)



Height limit

(This sign prohibits the entry of vehicles with an overall height in excess of 4.5m. The numerals on the sign may be altered to indicate different height restriction. Anyone who drives a vehicle with overall height exceeding 4.5m without police escort is committing an offence)



Weight limit

(This sign prohibits the entry of vehicles with weight laden or unladen in excess of 10 tonnes. The numerals on the sign may be altered to indicate different weight restriction. Anyone who drives a vehicle with laden or unladen weight exceeding 80 tonnes without police escort is committing an offence)



Speed limit

(Do not exceed 40 km/h)

(Do not exceed 70 km/h)



Speed limit
(Do not exceed 80 km/h)



Speed limit
(Do not exceed 90 km/h)



No sounding of horn
(Except to prevent accident)



No overtaking

No entry for vehicles with 3 or more axles



No entry for motorcycles



No entry for motorcycles and pedal cycles
